Instructions for using function panel keys1

○ On/Off

- ★ Short press the [on/off] key to start the power supply.
- ★ Long press the [on/off] key to turn off the digital piano.




★ In standby mode, it will automatically shut down in 30 minutes.

Volume

- ★ Main volume control: use the [volume] button to control the volume/
- ★ Rotate the 【volume】 knob to the right to increase the volume,
- *Rotate the [volume] knob to the leftt to decrease the volume. volume +
- ★ Before starting the power supply, turn the [volume] knob to the left to minimize the volume.


Previous/Play/Next

- ★ Short press the 【previous】 key to switch to the previous song, and long press to reduce the MP3 volume.
- ★ Short press the 【next】 key to switch to the next song, and long press to increase the MP3 volume.
- ★ Short press the [play] key to play the songs in MP3.
- ★ Long press the 【play】 key to stop playing the songs in MP3.



Start / Chord

- ★ Press the 【Start/Chord】button, start playing rhythm.
- ★ Press the 【Start/Chord】button ,stop playing rhythm.
- ★ Note: in playback, metronome, demonstration song and other modes, it will not automatically exit the rhythm playbackmode.



Instructions for using function panel keys2

Synchronous start and synchronous stop

★ Short press the 【synchronous start / stop】 key to turn on the synchronous start function, and the light will flash.




- ★ Short press the 【synchronization start / stop】 key to off the synchronization function.
- ★ When playing a chord, briefly press the 【synchronization start / stop】 key for the first time press the piano key in the A1-F4# range of the chord area to enter the synchronization mode.


For the chord synchronization part, please refer to the instructions of one-finger accompaniment or multi-finger accompaniment.

Insert / Dual keyboard

- ★ Press the 【insert/dual keyboard】 key without starting the rhythm.
- ★ Short press the 【insert / dual keyboard】 key to start the dual keyboard function.



- ★ Short press the 【Setting/Dual Tone】 key to select the keyboard separation point function.
- ★ Use the [+] key or the [-] key or directly press the piano key to select the separation point.
- ★ Shortpress the 【Settings/Dual Tone】 key to enter the setting state and select the left keyboard volume function to adjust the left keyboard volume.
- ★ The first time you press the 【insert/dual keyboard】 key to start the keyboard separation (i.e. dual keyboard) function,
- ★ The second short press of the [insert/dual keyboard] key to turn off the keyboard separation (i.e. dual keyboard) function.



Prelude and End

- ★ Short press the [prelude and endplay] key, and the light flashes.
- ★ Short press the 【start / chord】 key to indicate that the prelude has been started.
- ★ Long press the [prelude and endplay] key to end the endplay.







Metronome / Beat

- ★ This digital piano has a built-in metronome, which can be used as a reference for practice or performance.
- ★ Press the [metronome / beat] key for the first time to open the metronome, "Da, Da, Da" sound appears, and then long press the [metronome / beat] key. When the screen is 4 / 4, press the [+] key or [-] key to increase or slow down the beat speed.

The range: 1/4, 2/4, 3/4, 4/4, 5/4, 6/4, 3/8, 6/8, 12/8


★ Press the [metronome / beat] key for the second time to close the metronome.






Speed / Shift

- ★ Short press the [speed / transfer] key -- press the [+] key or [-] key to select The required rhythm. (Range: 20-280, Default Speed: 130)
- ★ Short press the 【start / stop / chord】 key to start the rhythm
- ★ Long press the 【start / stop / chord】key to start the chord function.
- ★ Long press the 【speed / transfer】 key -- press the 【+】 key or 【-】 key to select Transfer required. (range: 12-12, default: 00)
- ★ Be careful: After pressing within the range of key A1-F4#, the corresponding chord accompaniment can be played.








Store / Tuning


- ★ Long press the 【store / transfer 】 key to save the current state of the piano, including all parameters of timbre and rhythm type. When it is used again, short press the 【store / call】 key to call to quickly restore the piano to this state.
- ★ Short press the 【store / tuning】 key to transfer the function.





Set / Dual tone

★ Long press the 【setting/dual tone】 key to select dual tone Reverberation, chorus, double keyboard dynamics, tuning and other functions, Use the 【+】 key or 【-】 key to adjust.Reverberation (1-8), Chorus (1-8).

Timbre / Rhythm

- ★ Timbre: this digital piano has 200 timbres. See 【timbre list】 for details.
- ★ Under the default of startup, the default tone is 000 piano tone.
- ★ Long press the tone (tone / rhythm) key, press the (+) key or (-) key to select the desired tone.
- ★ Rhythm:this digital piano has 200 rhythms, which are carefully arranged by percussion rhythm and instrumental accompaniment, representing many different styles, and these styles are basically determined by rhythm type. See [rhythm list] in the attached table for details.
- ★ Short press the 【tone / rhythm】 key to switch to the rhythm selection state, and press the 【+】 key or 【-】 key to adjust.

Demo / Volume

★ This digital piano has built-in 100 demonstration songs to show a variety of timbres. Users can have a preliminary understanding of the digital piano through the demonstration music, See 【list of demo.songs】 for details of demo. tracks.




- ★ Short press the 【demo / volume】 key and select the desired track with the 【+】 key or 【-】 key.

 Short press to start or stop the demo song.
- ★ Long press the 【demo / volume】 key and use the 【+】 key or 【-】 key to select the desired volume. (range: 0-32, default: 32)



Record/ Play

★ Long press the 【record / play】 key to enter the recording preparation state, and the "Da, Da, Da", and then the 【record / play】 key light will flash. Press any piano key to start recording (the light is on for a long time). If the chord is turned on, the recording includes rhythm and melody, otherwise only melody is recorded.




- ★ Short press the 【record/play】 key to end the recording, and the light goes out at the same time.
- ★ Short press the 【record/play】 key to play the previously recorded music.


Timbre - Grand Piano

★ Short press [timbre 2] to set the timbre of electric piano 1, Press [+] or [-] to switch tracks (000-199)




Timbre - Rock organ

★ Short press 【timbre 3】 to change the timbre of the rolling organ, Press 【+】 or 【-】 to switch tracks (000-199)




Timbre - Synthetic string 2

★ Short press [timbre 4] to synthesize string 2 timbre, Press [+] or [-] to switch tracks (000-199)




Timbre - Brass Ensemble



Product Maintenance

Careful maintenance and protection of this product plays a very important role in prolonging the service life of the product and reducing faults.

1 Avoid heat, moisture or direct sunlight

Do not over expose the product to direct sunlight, or place it near the air conditioner or extremely hot place.

2 Do not use it near TV or radio

This product may cause video or audio interference to the reception of TV and radio. If this happens, move the product away from the TV or radio.

Do not use paint, thinner or similar chemicals for cleaning

Clean the product with a soft cloth wet with weak aqueous solution and neutral detergent. Soak the cloth in the solution and screw it dry until it is nearly dry.

4 Do not shake to avoid collision

The product should be handled with care when moving. Violent vibration and collision are strictly prohibited to avoid damage to the shell or internal electronic components.

Illustration of the back socket of the piano head





Illustration of the front key function of the piano head

Power Supply
